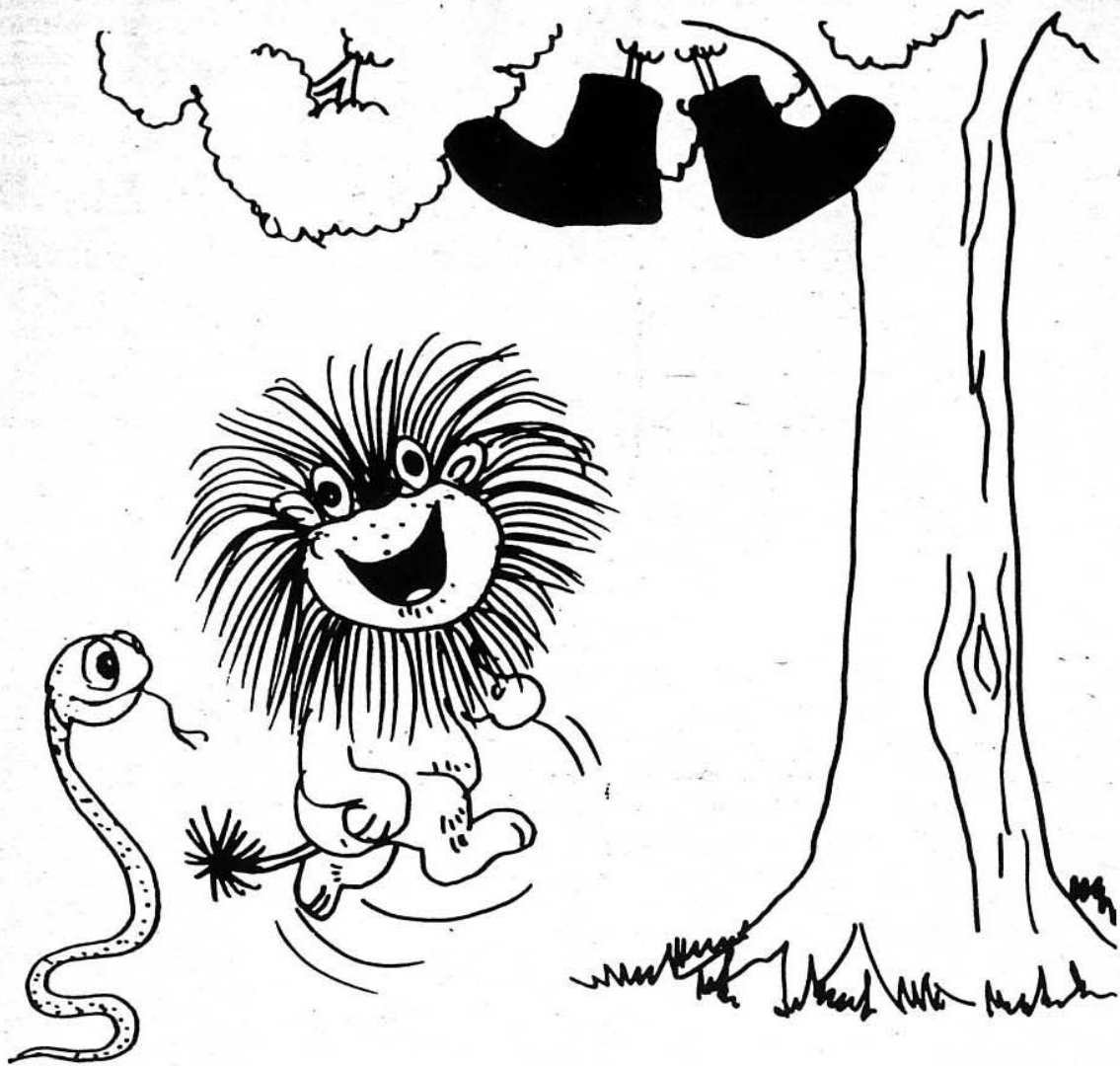

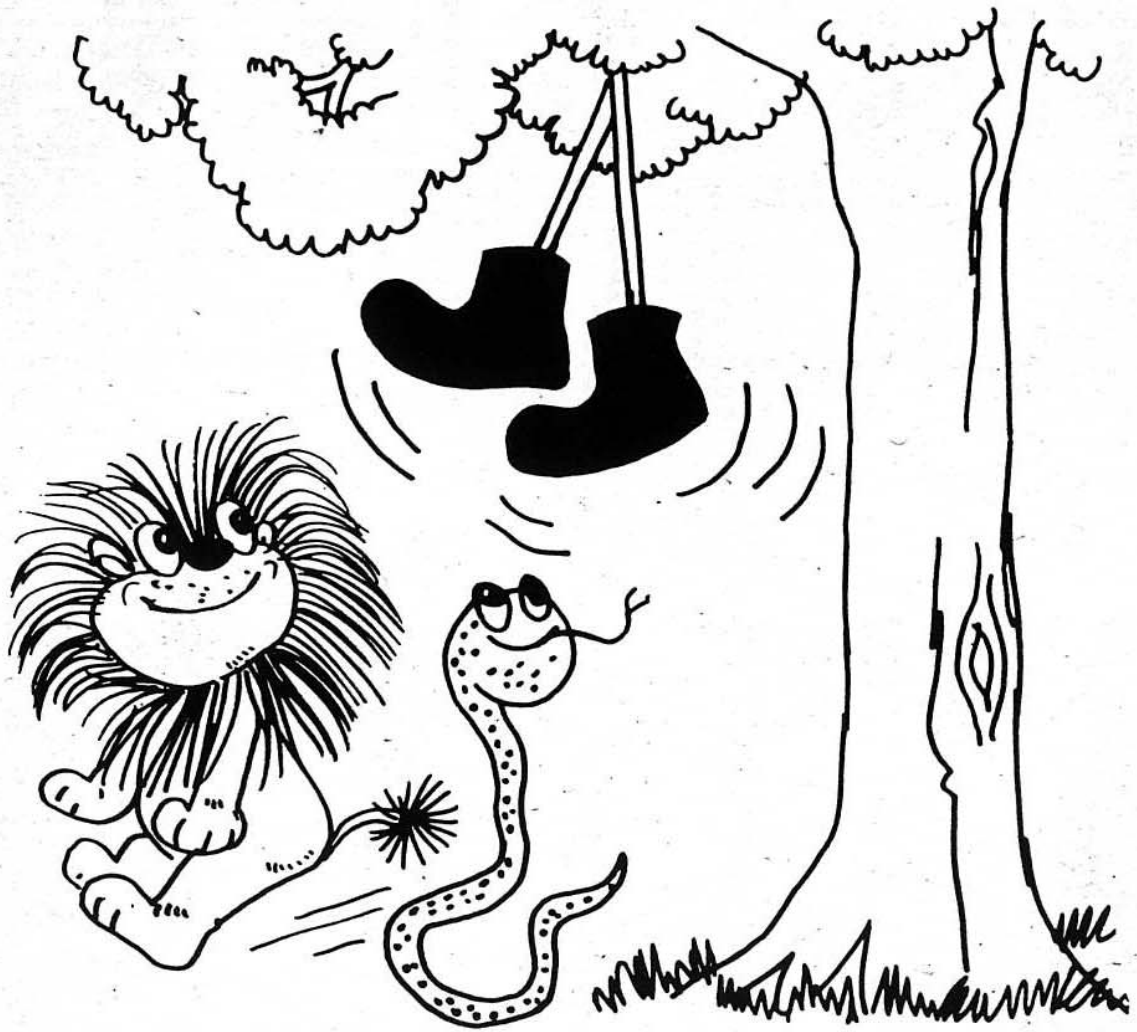


"What is that?"
