

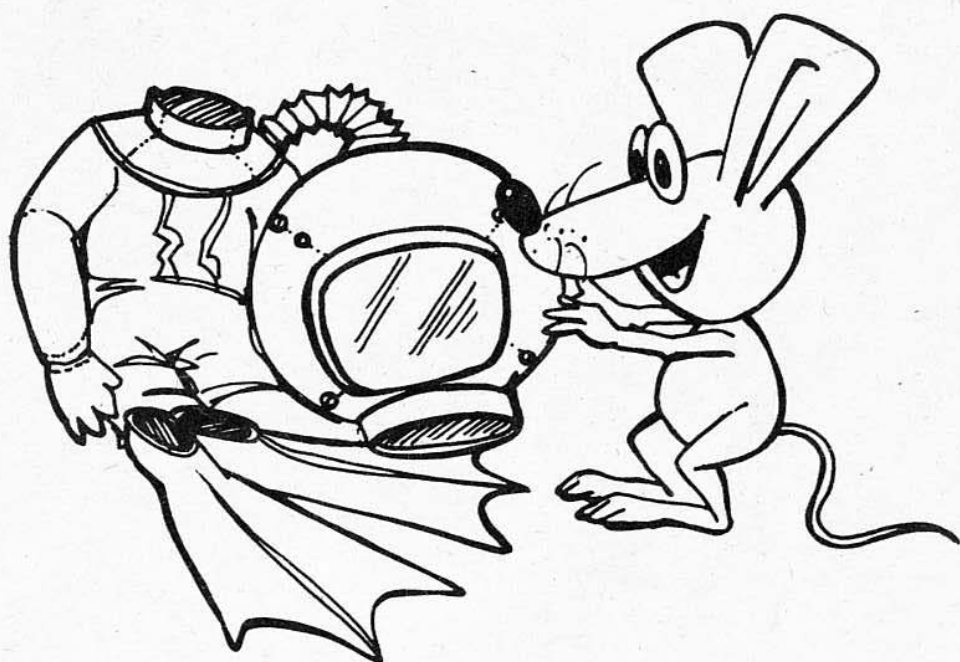

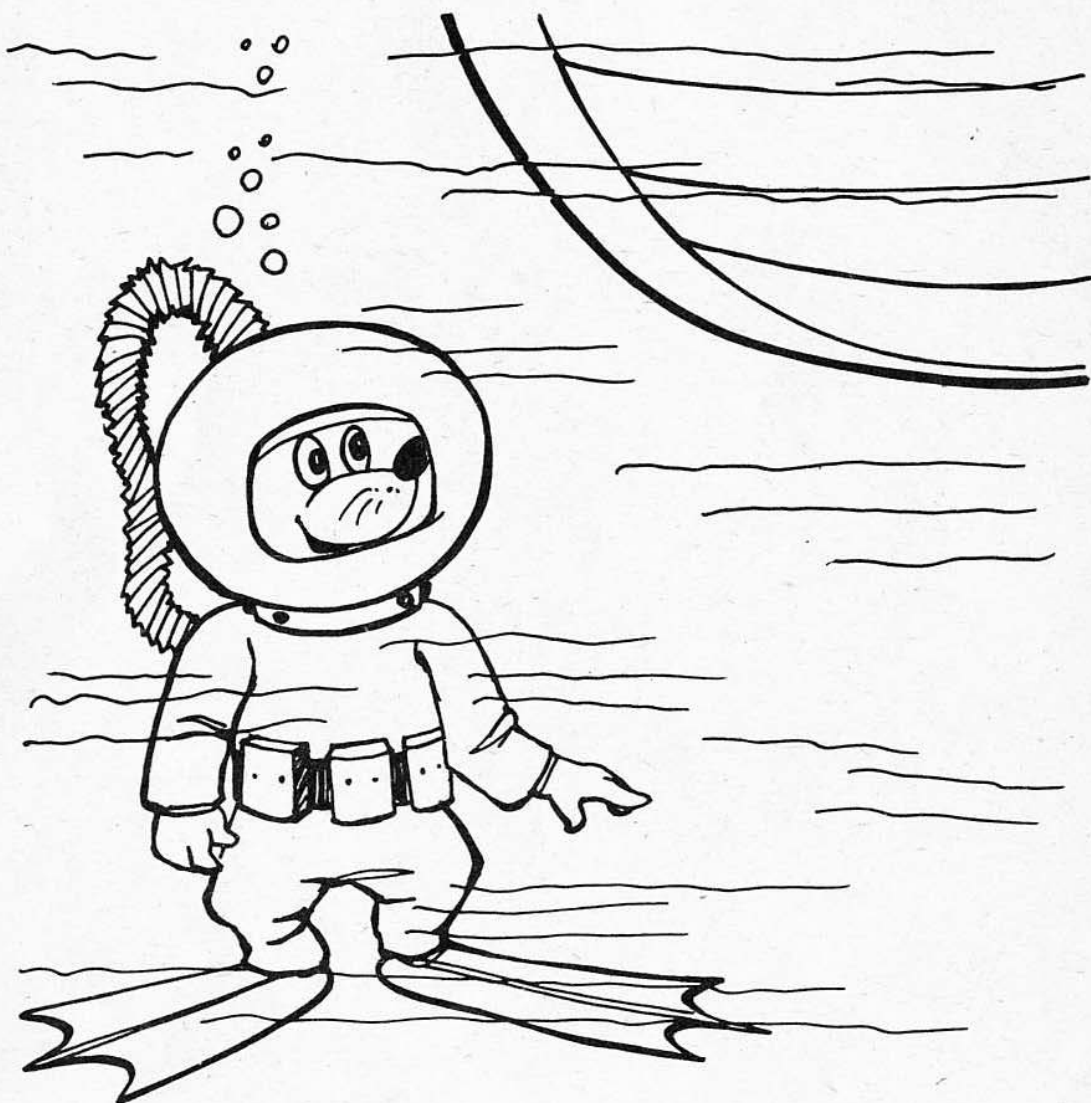

I need Mat."



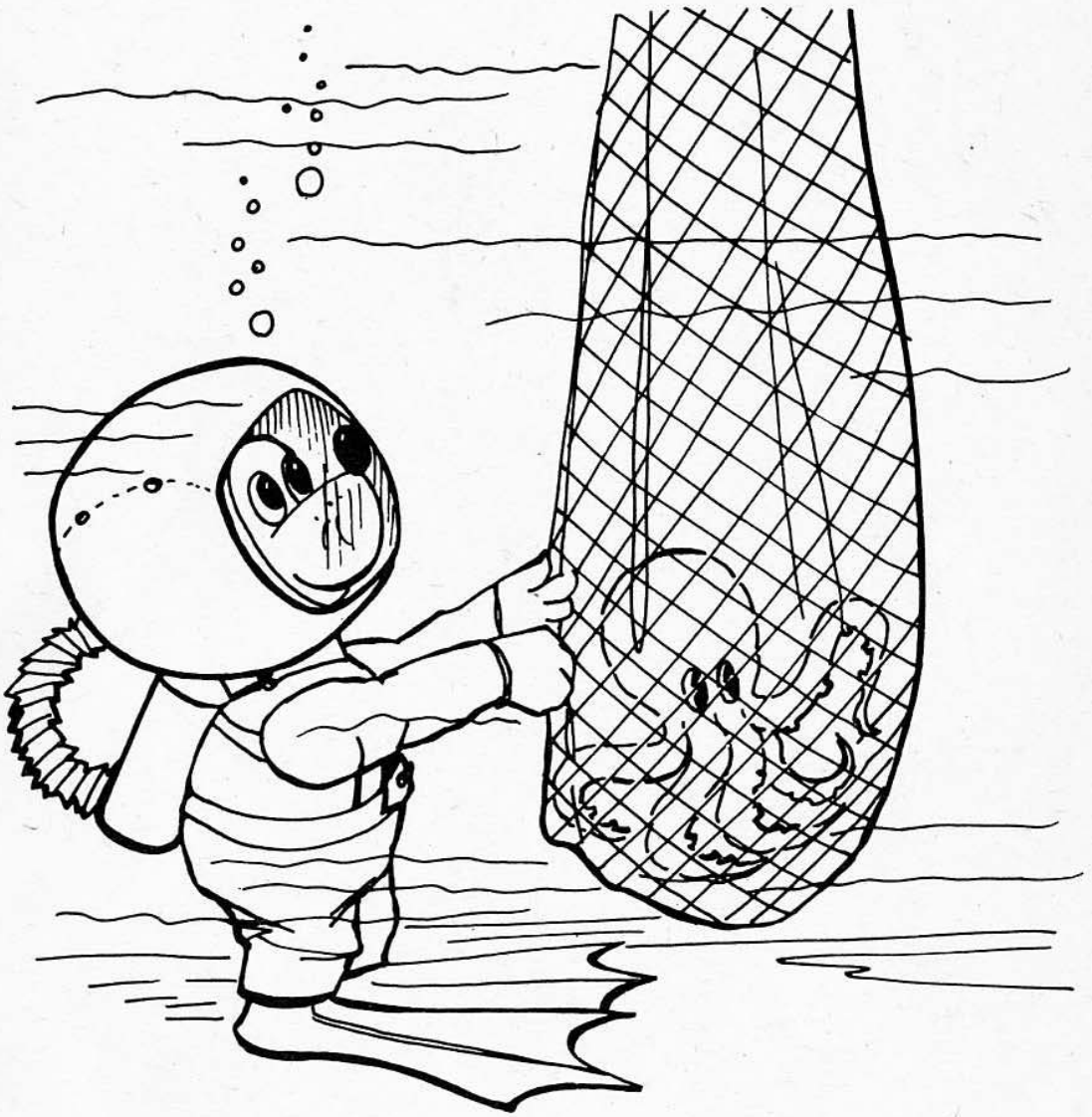
"Will Ann see me?"

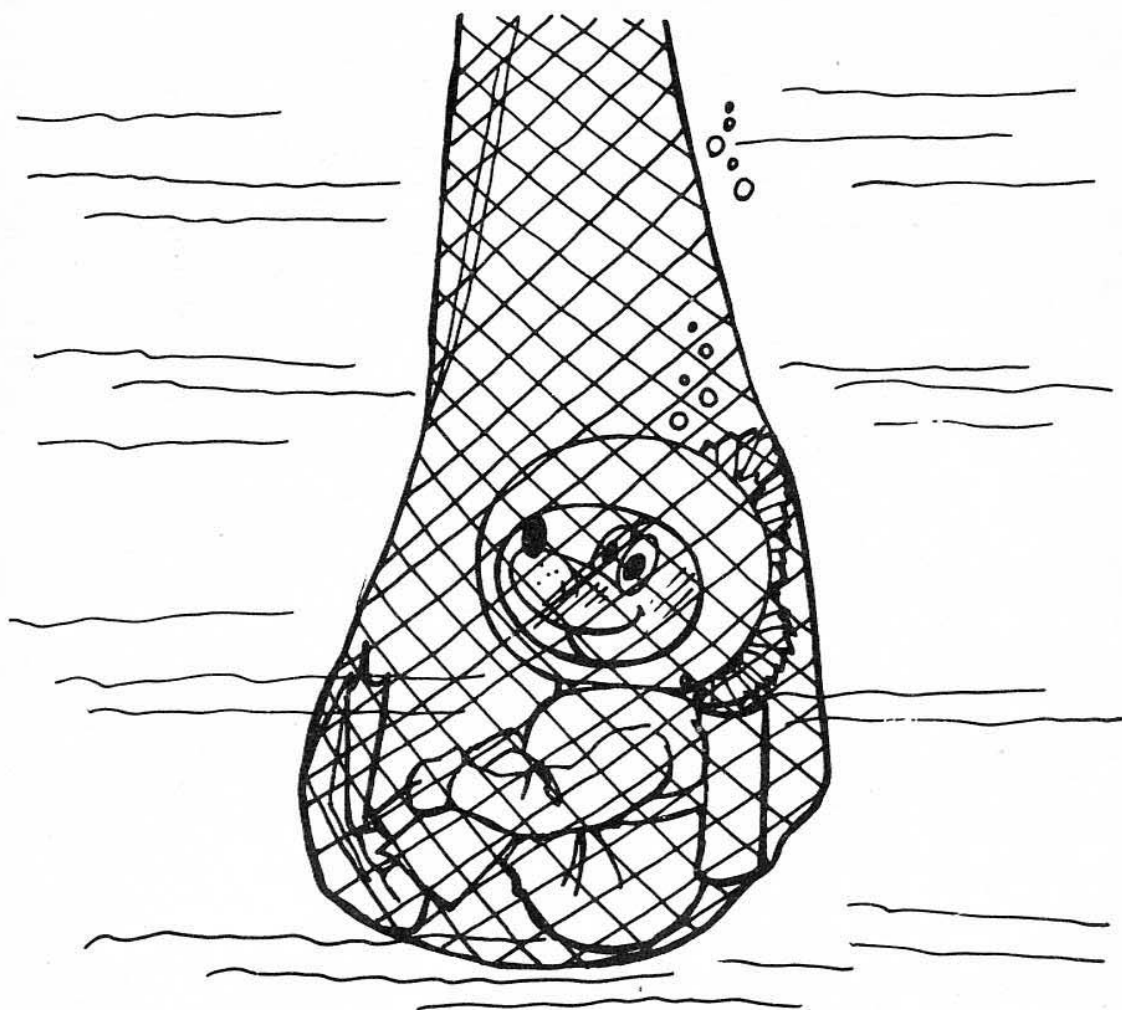

I am sad."



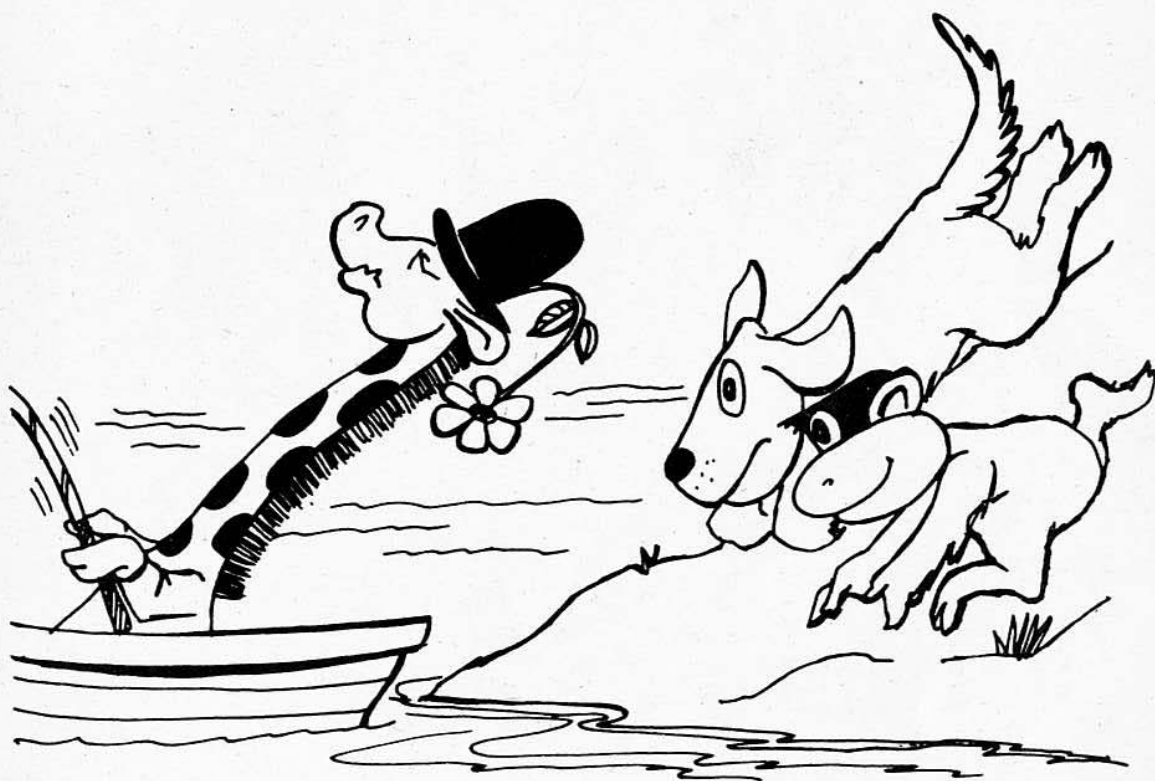
Mat sat in the net.

I am sad.”

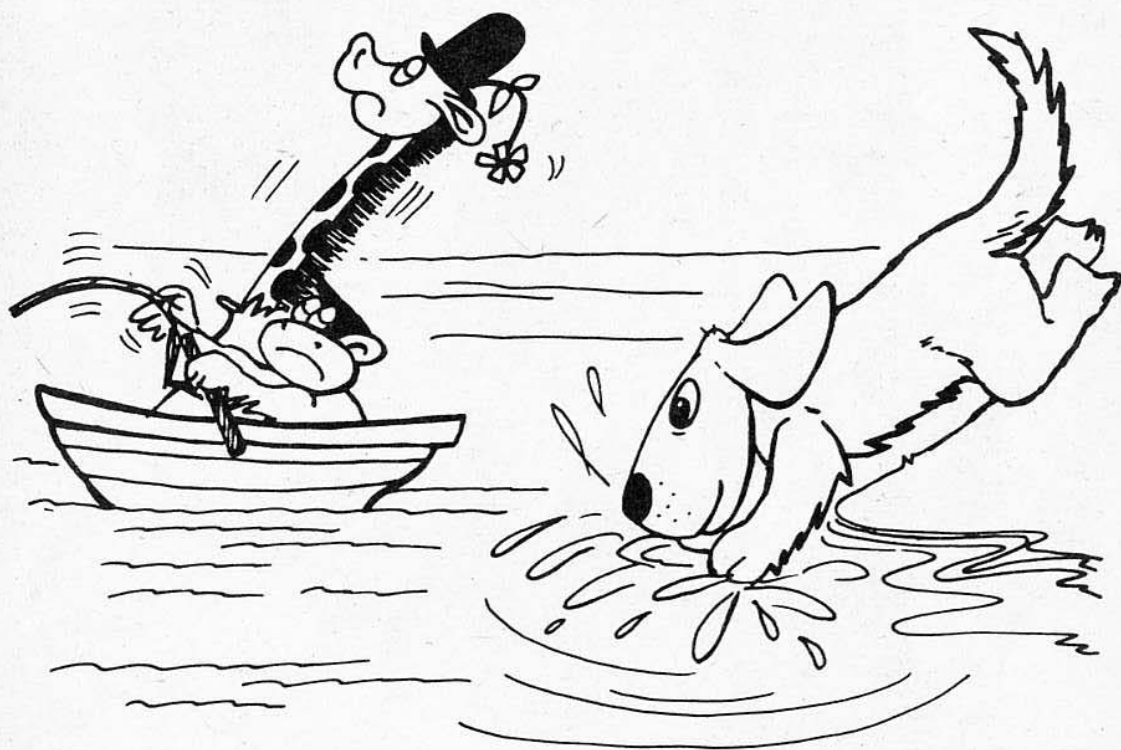

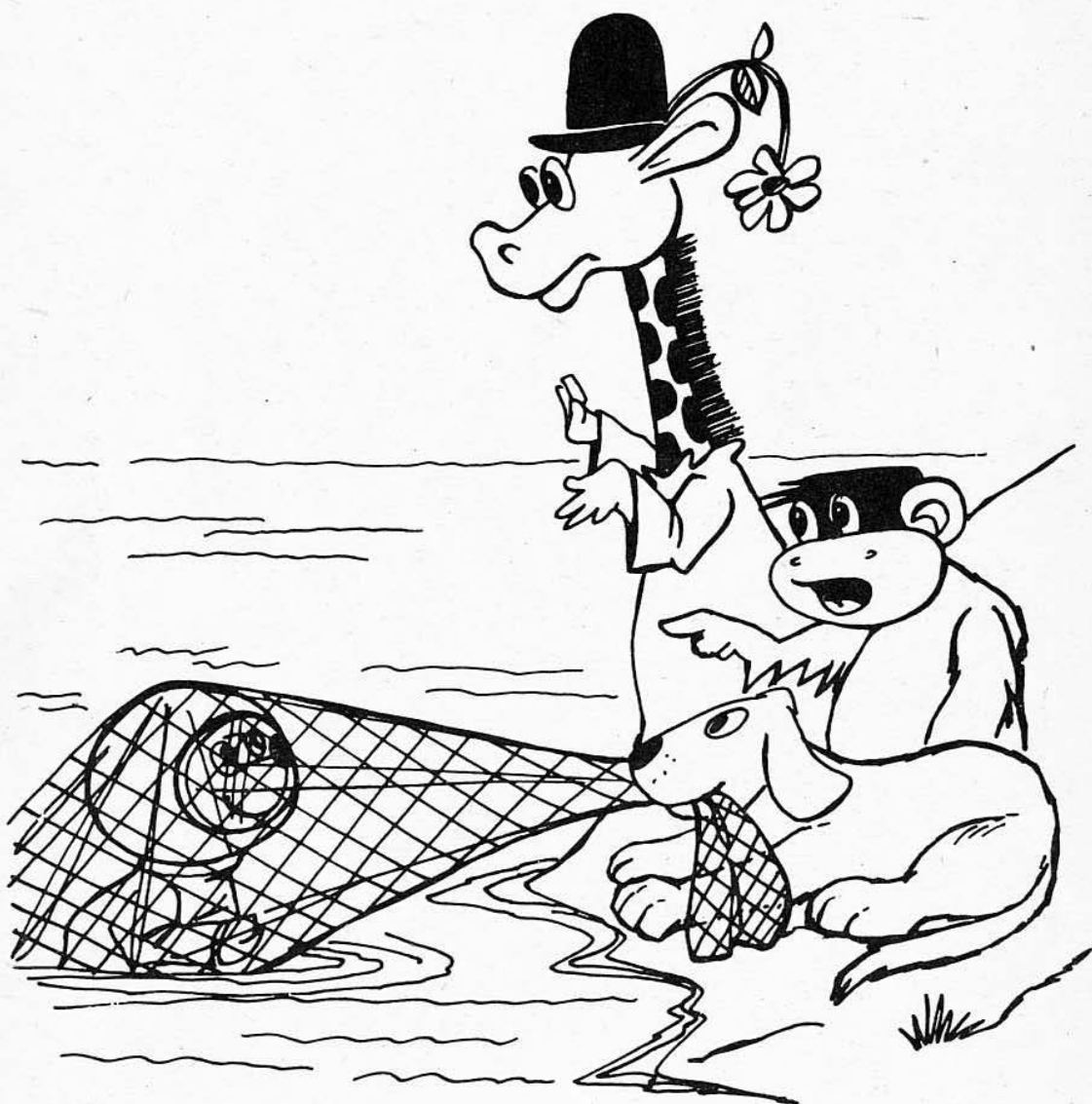

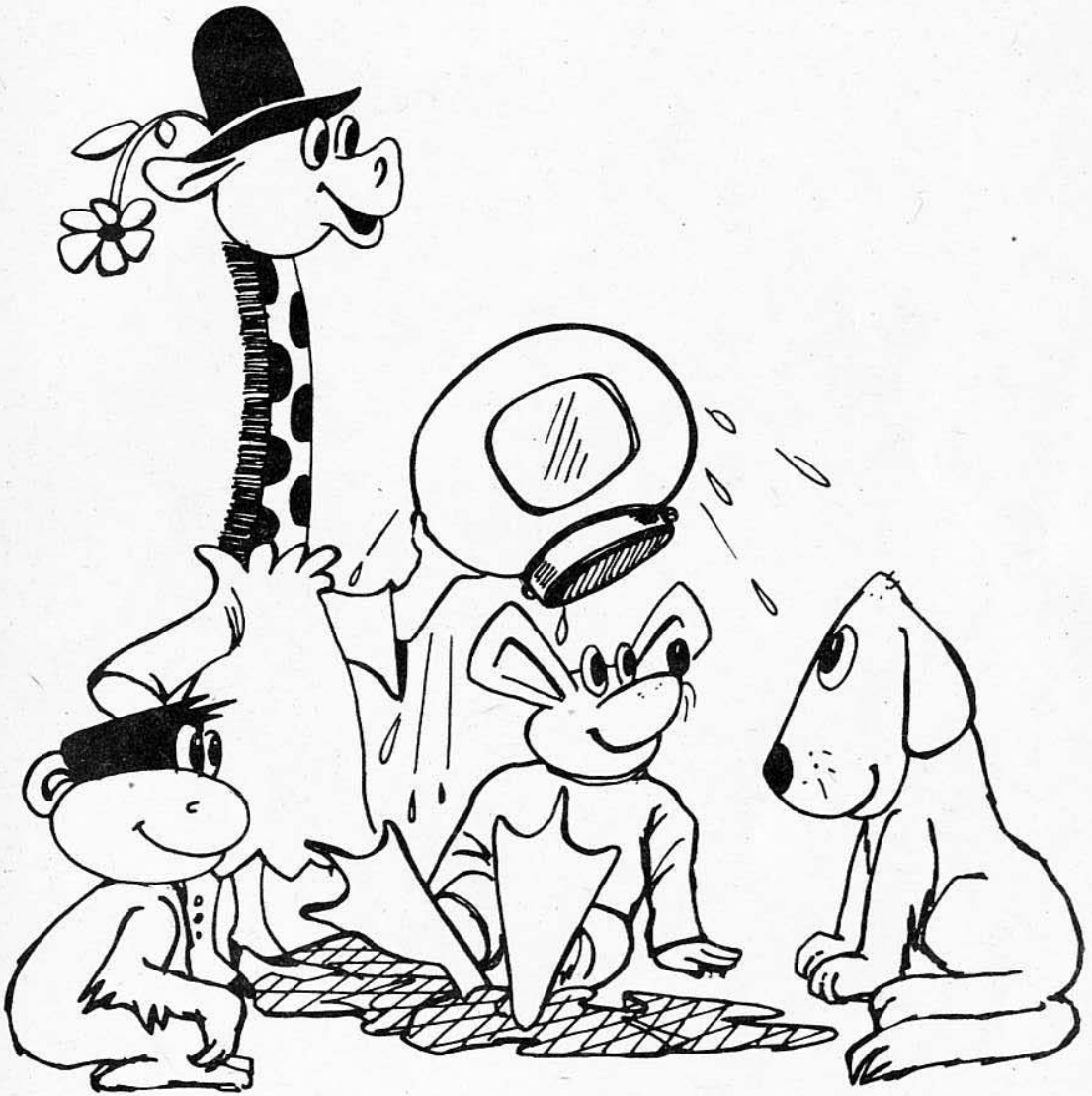

Is it a man?

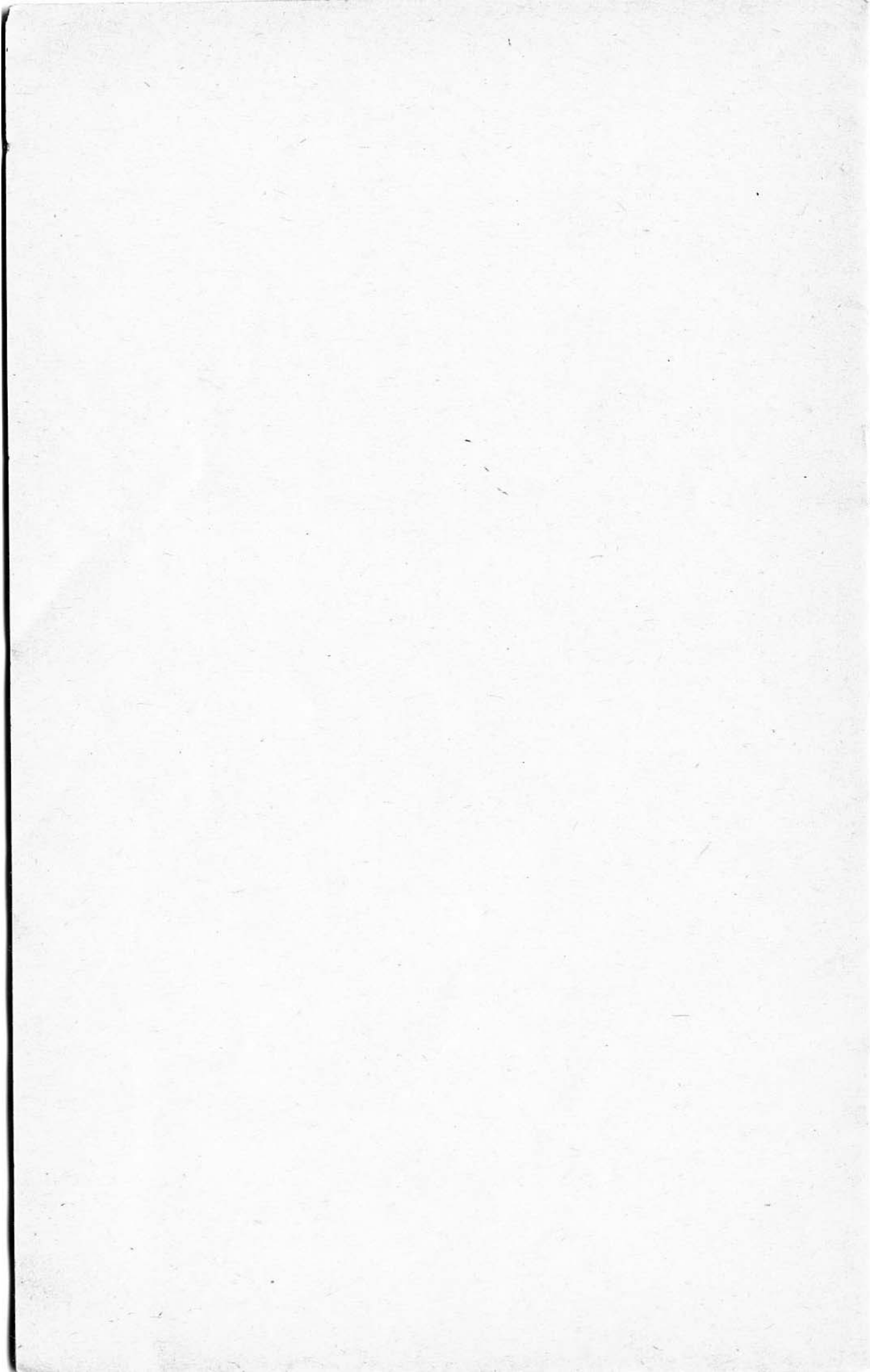
