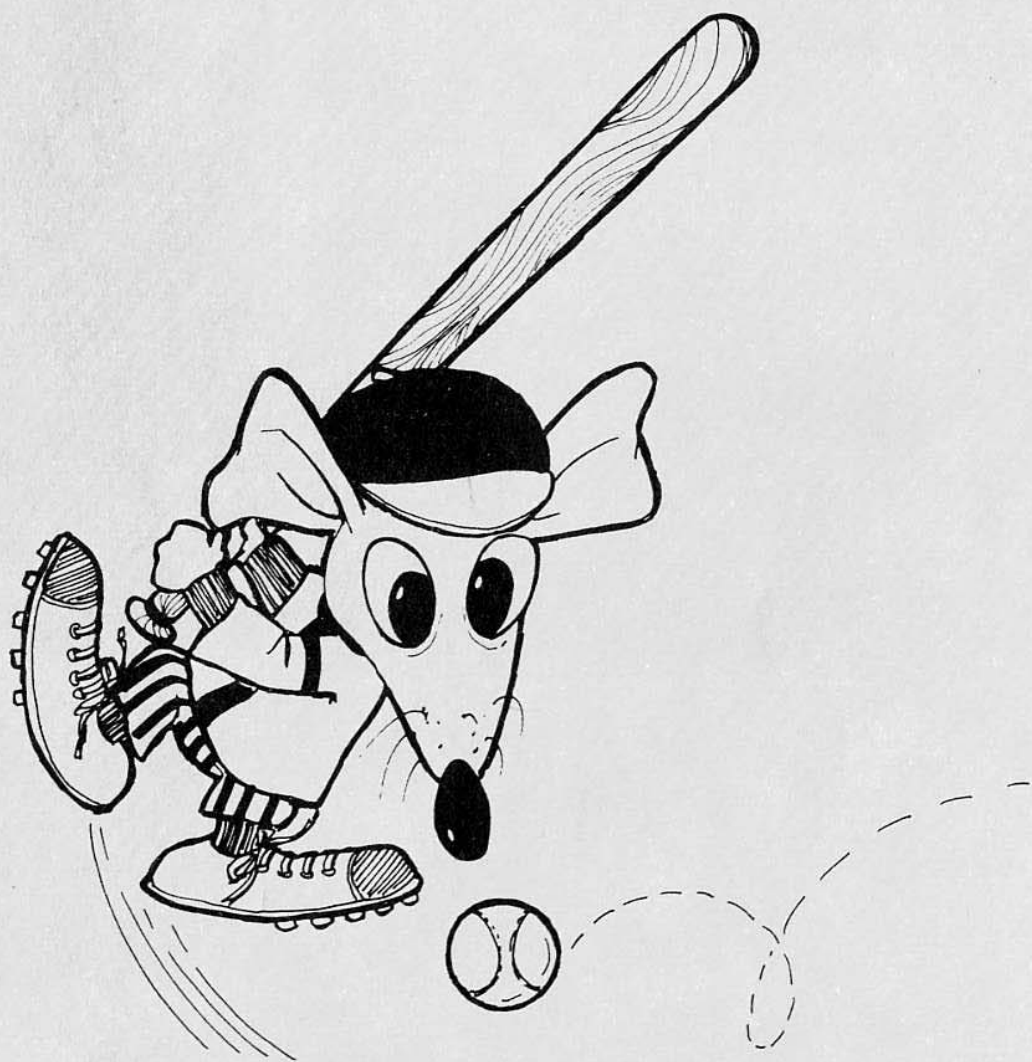

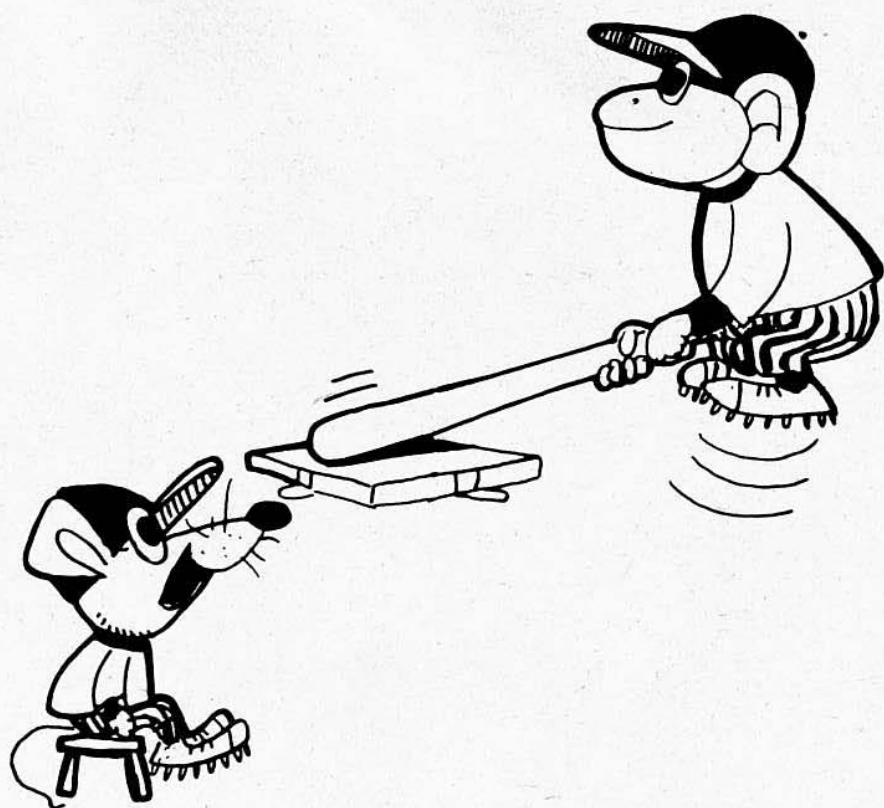

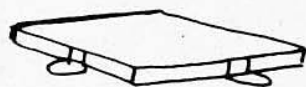


"See Mit.

That is his bat."



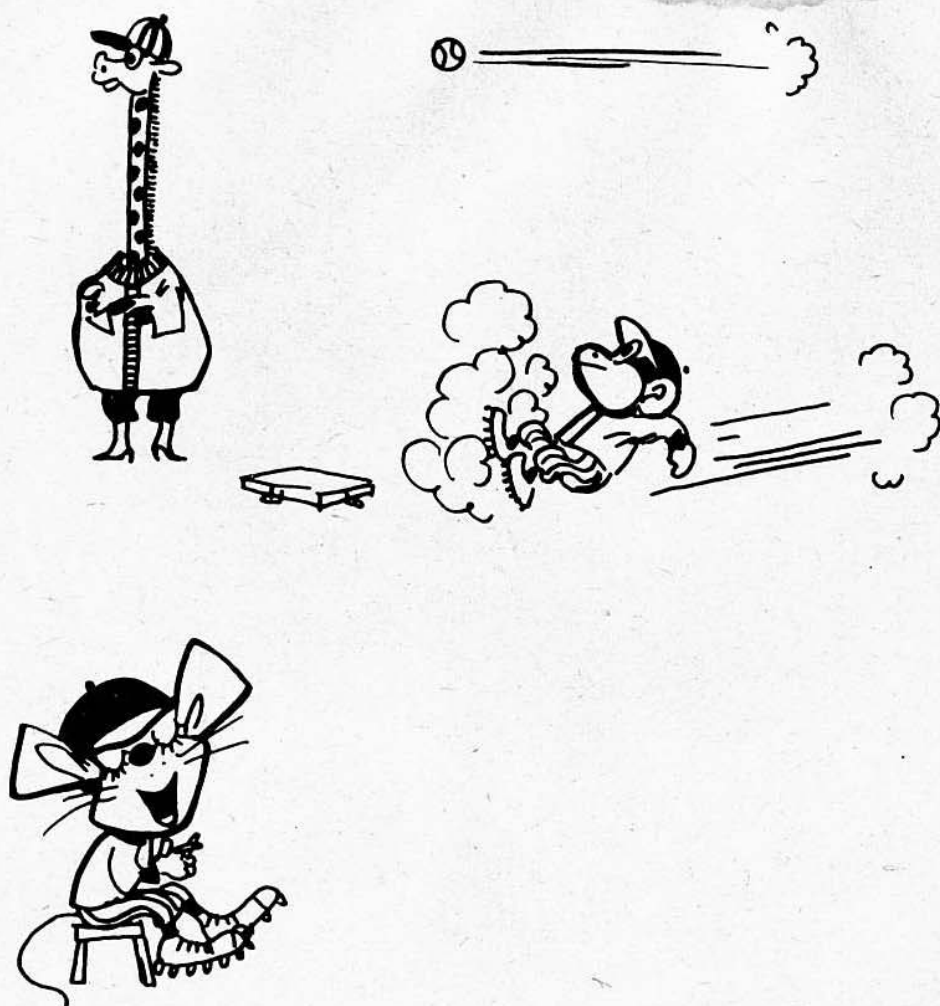
“Mit is at bat.

Hit the ball, Sam!

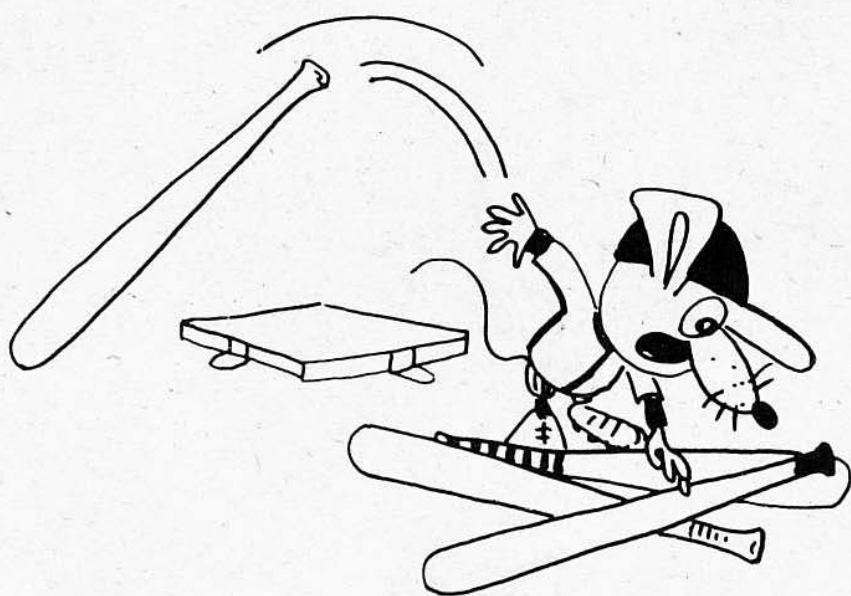
Hit it."



Sam hit the ball.

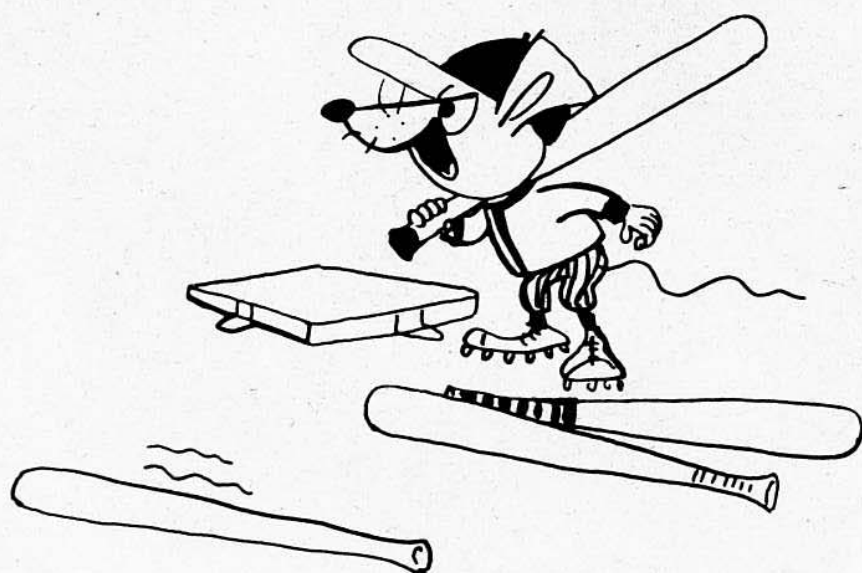
It was a bad hit.

I wish! I wish!”

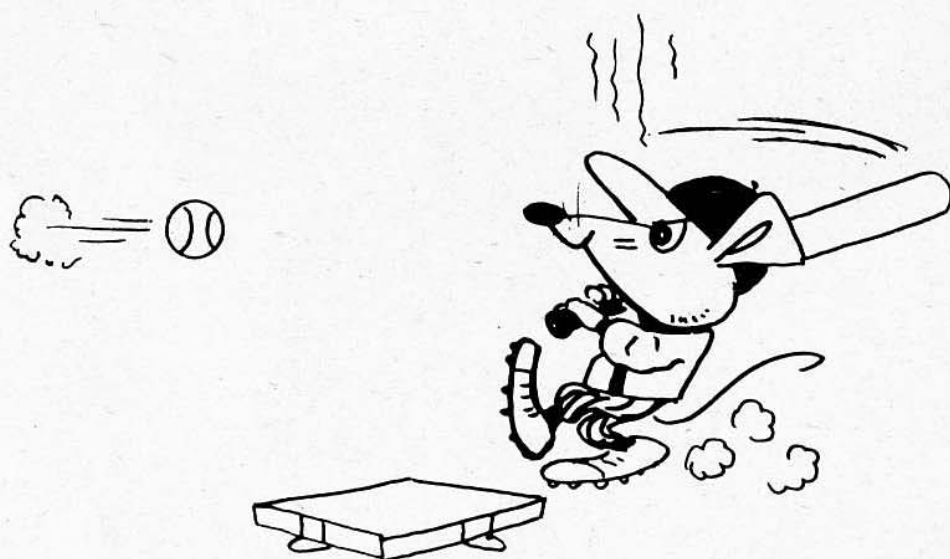


Did Mat wish that?
